Petition for Inquiry of EMR Network

Dear Ms. Dortch:

This supplements the Application for Review of EMR Network, filed January 10, 2002. So far as we are aware, the Application remains unopposed and is under consideration in the Office of Engineering and Technology ("OET"). In dismissing EMR Network's initial Petition for Inquiry, OET stated that any determination to inquire into revision of the referenced rules

should be made by [EPA and FDA] or other federal agencies with primary expertise in and responsibility for ensuring health and safety, and should not be made in the first instance by the FCC. Accordingly, any proceeding or inquiry should be initiated by and maintained under the auspices of such agency or agencies . . .¹


On January 31, 2002, EMR Network sent the attached letter to NIH and the other federal health and safety agencies shown as copied. Despite the passage of six months, we have heard back

from only four. (Exhibit 1) None of these respondents, and presumably none of those failing to respond, proposes to take the initiatives suggested in the Franca letter of dismissal.

EMR Network is disappointed in the number and nature of the responses, but not surprised. The rules in question have been issued by the FCC and the principal responsibility for their upkeep belongs with the FCC. EMR Network respectfully repeats the request in its Application for Review: That the Commission either open an inquiry or provide a reasoned explanation for not doing so.
